Welcome to your Daring Daughters E-Course!

Daring Daughters is a 12-week mentoring course for women and next generation leaders. This course is especially designed for you, as mother and daughter, as mentors and girls, or as sisters in Jesus, to grow closer together as you grow closer to God. A dual-focus is God's Great Commandment and God's Great Commission – loving God and loving others. Throughout this course, we'll learn about world needs that should concern us as Christian women. Together, we can help to expand God's kingdom and to be a light for Jesus, as we rise up to God's call. Throughout this course, we'll begin to move forward on specific goals YOU have for your lives.

We'll dream together, pray together,
and begin to make targeted steps for action and change.

What is a Daring Daughter?

In the Great Commission (in Matthew 28:19), Jesus commanded us to “Go into all the world and make disciples of all nations.” As a Daring Daughter, we’re girls who DARE to obey God. We’re disciples of Jesus Christ who love God and love others. We’re not pampered princesses; but disciplined daughters who will advance the kingdom of God.

Key Themes:

- To call for the “skillful wailing women” (experienced women of God)

Thus says the LORD of hosts: “Consider and call for the mourning women, that they may come; and send for skillful wailing women, that they may come. Let them make hast and take up a wailing for us, that our eyes may run with tears, and our eyelids gush with water . . .”

- To “teach your daughters wailing” (teach the next generation how to cry)

“Yet hear the word of the LORD, O women, And let your ear receive the word of His mouth; Teach your daughters wailing . . .” (Jeremiah 9:17-18, 20)

Advantages of mother-daughter mentoring:

- Moms are instructed to teach their children diligently:

⁶“And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. ⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.” (Deuteronomy 6:6-7)

- Older women are called to train the younger women.

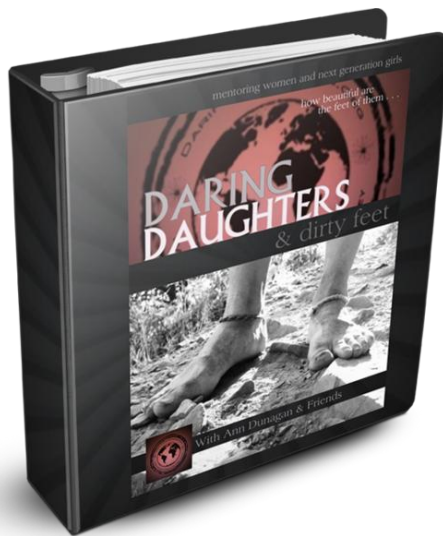
³the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things— ⁴that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, ⁵to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.” (Titus 2:3-5)

- As moms and daughters, we know each other and love each other. We will be in relationship throughout our entire life. It’s a relationship worth investing in.
- Daughters have dreams, energy, and fresh ideas. Moms have wisdom, experience, and perspective. Together, we can help each other fulfill God’s purposes.
- We’re around each other, so we can hold each other accountable.

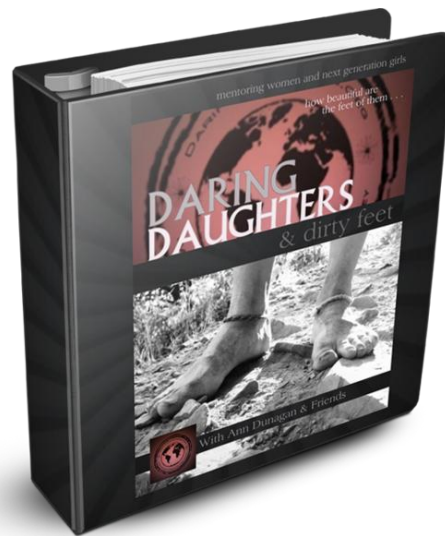
How do we begin?

1. Make your notebooks.

You will need to purchase 3-ring-binders for each participant, one for each mom or mentor and one for each next-generation girl (in this course, we're all daughters!). If desired, purchase (or find) black 3-ring-binders with clear "pockets" on the front. Make copies of our DARING DAUGHTERS cover and insert into each notebook.

Each week, you will download your DARING DAUGHTER "Weekly Action Packs" to print, one for each woman participating. Before each week's session, print your ACTION PACK, punch holes in these pages, and insert in your binders.

A few more things to gather together: You will need extra NOTEBOOK PAPER (for writing answers to our mentoring questions and for jotting notes and thoughts), a good PEN and a HIGHLIGHTER for each of you, and a 3-hole puncher. For fun, perhaps prepare something to enjoy during this time together (such as tea in special tea-cups, hot chocolate or coffee with whipped cream, or a special fruit or chocolates).

2. Establish a specific MENTORING TIMES for you to work together on this E-course.

- Each week includes approximately 1 hour of mp3 audio training (in two 30-minute mp3 downloads). You can listen to these together, or individually. You can listen to the teachings (via headphones) while you complete your household chores, or while you exercise.
- Plan a specific time each week to meet together to talk together about the lesson and to review the ACTION PACK download.
- Visit DaringDaughters.org to participate in LIVE group coaching, Teleconferencing calls, Team meetings (with various themes), or listen to a LIVE online Bible study.



PRINT the ACTION PACK:

Begin each week by **printing out your weekly ACTION PACKS** for each participant. **Punch holes** in these papers and **put them in your notebooks**.

LISTEN to the LESSON:

Listen to the teachings (and interviews) on the weekly Daring Daughter E-Course AUDIOS:

You can listen online, or on-the-go (via mp3). Most lessons are recorded Daring Daughter interviews or teachings with special mentors and leaders. These

real-life ladies have fascinating perspectives and experiences that will bless you and challenge you. If you listen on-the-go, be sure to look at the ACTION PACK before your mentoring time.

TALK TOGETHER & READ YOUR BIBLES:

After you listen to each week's E-Course audio lesson, **Sit together and discuss that week's ACTION PACK and mentoring questions**. Discuss the weekly theme and share how you agree (or disagree) with the opinions shared. Look up the Bible verses and read them together. Answer the questions. Ask how you can pray specifically for each other.

PRAY TOGETHER:

Pray about that week's theme and pray for each other.

During the week, take some quiet time to work independently to brainstorm and to write down answers to your weekly ACTION PACK questions. As moms (or mentors) and daughters, talk together off-and-on (or text each other or discuss online), or ask questions and add your own thoughts . . . as you go about your schedule.

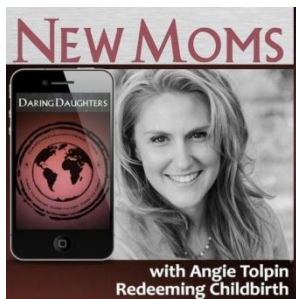
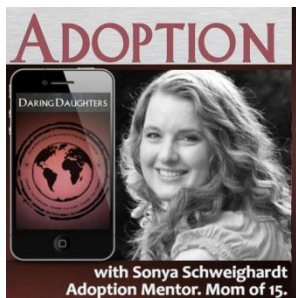
